The economy is growing. Many are doing well. So why is it so difficult to get government to invest in things that could make communities stronger? Why is it so hard to fund improvements to public transportation or increase access to higher education?

One challenge is the false notion that even very small increases in top tax rates cause wealthy people to move away. Professor Cristobal Young of Cornell University did a groundbreaking analysis of millions of tax returns to test that idea -- and his results are stunning.
